

<u>Ticket and Registration prices include the following:</u>

3 days of Full access to both the Creation Museum and the Ark Encounter
This includes:

- Access to all exhibits and activities at the Creation Museum on Sunday
- 2 days of access to the Ark itself and all activities and events on the Ark Campus (Wednesday & Thursday)
- Access to all activities except the Ark itself (Monday & Tuesday)
- The cost of the Picnic on Sunday and the cost of the Banquet on Thursday. The children will be given a snack to tie them over until they can have lunch with their parents.

This DOES NOT include:

Parking fees (which will be \$10/day, buses free)

Access to the Ark itself or the Creation Museum for Monday & Tuesday

 We do have access to all the other attractions at the Ark encounter campus for the 4 days we are on site. On Monday and Tuesday, you can still go to the Zoo, eat at any of the restaurants, go on the zip line, watch the Virtual Reality movie, etc. The only thing you cannot do on Monday and Tuesday is go into the Ark.

Please note that if the teens go on the Zip Line or go to the Virtual Reality movie as part of their activities with Pastor Schiele, those costs will be covered by the teen as well as any food they may purchase while exploring the campus.

Hotel Information

We have 2 facilities for the 2025 Conference with a block of rooms reserved at each. The hotels are located in Dry Ridge, KY and are across the street from each other. A Hampton Inn and a Home2 (which is more family friendly). Both provide a free breakfast. The cost is \$150/night plus tax and the cutoff for room reservations is June 10th, 2025.
